01	In honor of National Science Fiction Day on January 2nd, read a hard sci-fi novel rooted in actual, real-world science.	
02	In honor of Tell a Fairy Tale Day on February 26th, Read a retelling of a classic fairy tale or myth.	
03	In honor of National Write Down Your Story Day on March 14th, read a memoir or autobiography.	
04	In honor of National Deep Dish Pizza Day on April 5th, read a novel set in Chicago.	
05	In honor of National Paranormal Day on May 3rd read a haunted house or ghost story.	
06	In honor of Juneteenth (June 19th) commemorating the end of slavery in the United States, read a nonfiction book about anti-racism.	
07	National Moon Day on July 20th commemorates the day man first walked on the moon in 1969. To celebrate, read a book about NASA and the Space Program.	
08	In honor of National Tell a Joke Day on August 16th, read a comedy book.	
09	In honor of Talk Like A Pirate Day on September 19th, read a book set on the high seas.	
10	In honor of National Pierogi Day on October 8th read a book by a Polish author.	
11	In honor of International Day for the Elimination of Violence against Women on November 25th, read a thriller that does not feature women as victims.	
12	Nobel Prizes are presented to new laureates on December 10th. Celebrate by reading a Nobel winning novel.
